Motion #2014-03-26-28-2881 – Blackmore/Cooper

Be it resolved that we rescind motion #2014-03-11-2858.

Motion #2014-03-26-2882 – Blackmore/Tulk

Be it resolved that property owners with more than one property in the town will be charged a minimum property tax on their primary residence (vacant or not) and a minimum property tax of \$100.00 will apply to each additional property.

In favour 7; Opposed 0; Motion Carried

Motion #2014-03-26-2883 – Cullimore/Stagg

Be it resolved that property owners with multiple vacant land that has no primary residence will pay no less than the minimum property tax.

Motion #2014-03-26-2884 – Johnson/Cooper

Be it resolved that individuals with multiple properties in the town with a dwelling on more than one of these properties will be charged a minimum property tax on each of these properties.

Motion #2014-03-26-2885 – Blackmore/Cullimore

Be it resolved that there will be no adjustments given on water and sewer rates where water has been disconnected at the curbside for any period of time during the year. A \$100.00 minimum water tax will apply to properties not permanently lived in that have their water services disconnected for more than one year.
